**THIRD PUBLIC SESSION ON FUTURE TRANSIT PLANS  
FOR WAKE COUNTY TO BE HELD ON JUNE 22, 2009**

Research Triangle Park, NC - (June 1, 2009) - The third public session to discuss Wake County's future transit plans has been scheduled for Monday, June 22 beginning at 7 P.M. in the Council Chambers at 316 N. Academy Street in Cary. Previous sessions were held in Raleigh in March and Rolesville in April.

The Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) is completing work on the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) for the region. Bus and rail improvements will be discussed at the session along with ways to fund transit enhancements.
