TRIANGLE TRANSIT TO MAKE SERVICE CHANGES NEXT MONTH

Research Triangle Park, N.C. (July 26, 2010) - Triangle Transit will make adjustments to many bus routes in mid-August. The changes, effective Monday, August 16 will:

- Improve service reliability and on-time performance
- Simplify route design and the route naming and numbering system
- Improve transfer connections between Triangle Transit and DATA
- Affect the timing of transfers at the Regional Transit Center
- Provide direct service to RDU International Airport from downtown Raleigh
