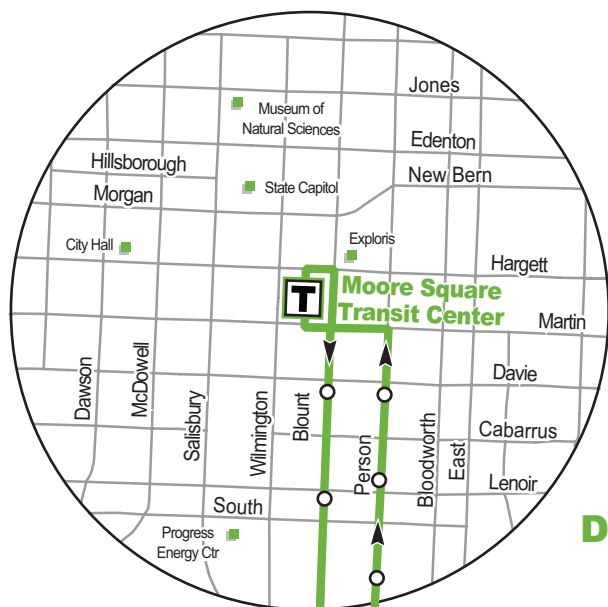

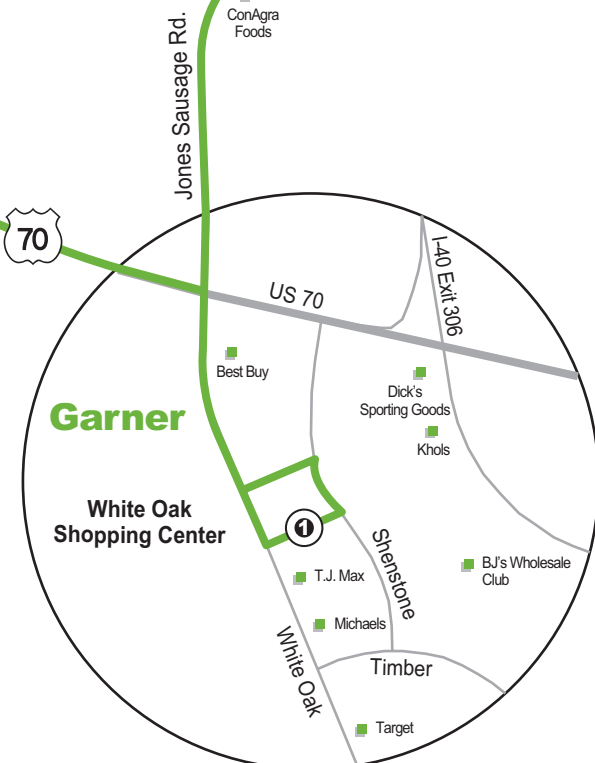
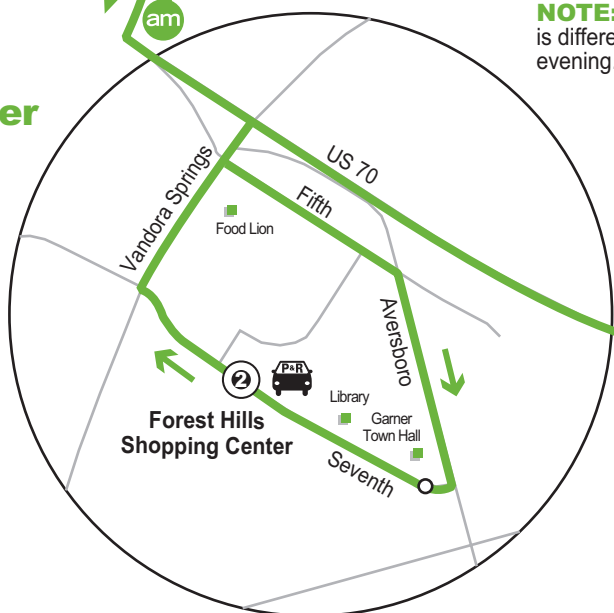

Forest Hills Shopping Center, Garner:

Located behind the shopping center, in the Fidelity Bank parking lot. From US-70 East, take the Vandora Springs Road exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp on to Vandora Springs Rd. Turn left on to 7th Avenue, and the bank will be on your left. The bus stop is located on 7th Ave near the entrance to the Forest Hills Apartments.
