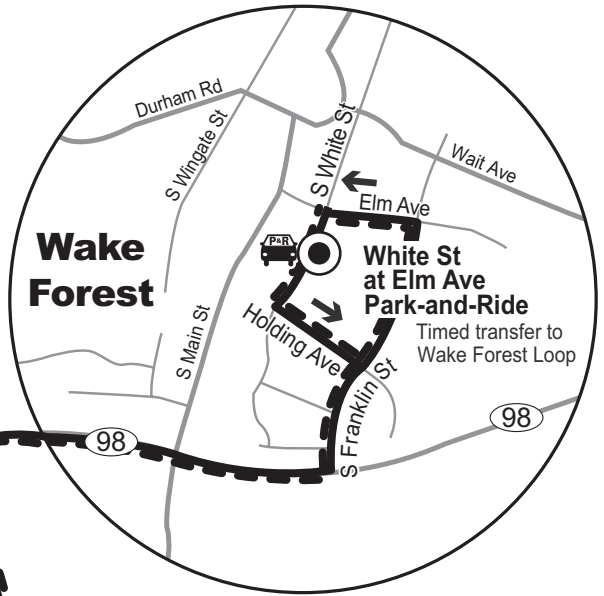


## Wake Forest - Raleigh Express

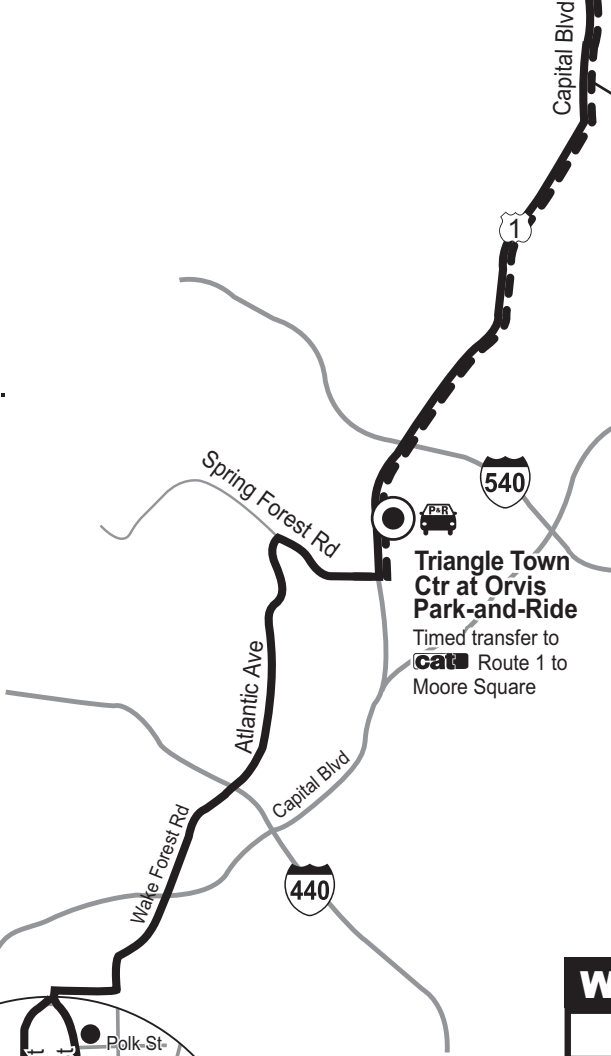
-  Major Stops

Dotted line represents midday service, which runs between downtown Wake Forest and Triangle Town Center only.



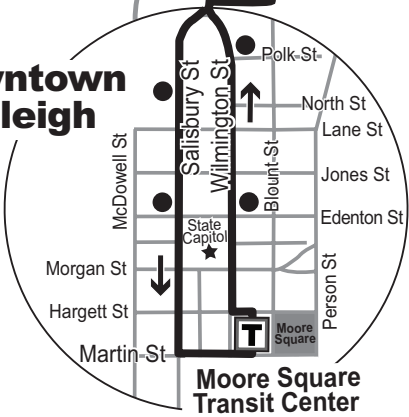

**White St at Elm Ave, Wake Forest:**

From Main Street (US 1A), turn east on Elm Ave. The lot is located just past the railroad tracks on the right. Access the lot from White St. The Triangle Transit bus stop is located between the entrance and exit to the Park and Ride lot on White St.

**Triangle Town Ctr at Orvis, Raleigh:**

From Capital Blvd (US 1), turn east on Sumner Blvd. Take a left into the Triangle Town Center parking lot. The lot is located to the right near Orvis. The Triangle Transit bus stop is located at the shelter between Sumner Blvd. and the mall access road. Please be courteous and leave the double row of spaces nearest the businesses for customers' use.

**\$ Discounts**
