Triangle Transit Board of Trustees Schedules Budget Worksessions

Research Triangle Park, NC (April 22, 2009) -The Triangle Transit Board of Trustees will hold a worksession on Monday, April 27th from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to review the proposed FY 2010 Budget.

The Board's Operations and Finance Committee will review the budget during its meeting at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 7th.

The first Public Hearing on the budget is scheduled during the Board's monthly meeting on Wednesday, May 27th at 1 p.m.

Operations and Finance Committee members will have a final review of the budget on Thursday, June 4th at 1:30 p.m.

The second Public Hearing and adoption of the FY2010 Budget is scheduled for 1 p.m. on Wednesday, June 24th during the Board's regular monthly meeting.

All budget sessions will be held in the Board Room at 4600 Emperor Blvd, Suite 100, Durham, NC.
