### Raleigh City Councillor Joins Triangle Transit Board

Research Triangle Park, NC (March 25, 2009) - Raleigh City Councillor Mary Ann Baldwin has joined the Triangle Transit Board of Trustees.

Baldwin joined the Board at today's monthly meeting. She replaces Jean Davis, who'd served as a Raleigh representative for the last 18 months.

Baldwin is the president of Baldwin Communications, a strategic marketing and business development firm. She has more than 25 years of professional experience in the fields of journalism, marketing and communications.

In addition to her professional career, Mary-Ann currently serves as a City Councillor, representing the City of Raleigh at Large. She serves on the Public Works Committee and the Comprehensive Planning Committee, as the City's liaison to the State Legislative Delegation, and as the City's representative on the Metropolitan Mayor's Coalition. She is also involved with the Greater Raleigh Chamber of Commerce, serving on the Board of Advisors and the Inter-City Visit and Leadership Committee Task Force.

Triangle Transit is governed by a 13-member Board of Trustees. Ten members are appointed by the region's principal municipalities and counties to staggered four-year terms. Three ex officio non-voting members are appointed by the North Carolina Secretary of Transportation. The Board of Trustees transacts business for Triangle Transit and meets on the fourth Wednesday of every month at 4600 Emperor Drive, Suite 100, Durham, NC.
